PROCEDURE FOR THE REMOVAL OF UNDECLARED CONTAMINATED WASTE (ASBESTOS) FOUND TO BE DISCARDED IN A KANGA BIN

The hirer accepts all responsibility for the waste deposited in the Kanga Bin.

Contaminated waste deposited in a Kanga Bin is defined as illegal dumping.

Contaminated waste deposited in a Kanga Bin carries heavy fines and clean up penalties.

The hirer accepts all responsibility and is therefore subject to any litigation as a result from contaminated waste being deposited.

PROCEDURE

Waste from Kanga Bins is disposed of at landfills in Rockhampton, Yeppoon and Gracemere.

If contaminated waste is discovered when emptying a bin, Landfill staff will notify Kanga Bins immediately.

Upon notification, Kanga Bins will contact Darrens Asbestos Removal and engage their services for the safe removal of the contaminated waste.

Darrens Asbestos Removal will contact the hirer of the bin and notify them of his intentions and their obligations.

The hirer may at this time request an analysis be carried out by an accredited laboratory.

Darrens Asbestos Removal engages the services of Parsons Brinckerhoff Australia P/L.

Darrens Asbestos Removal will also contact the Department of Environment and Resource Management (DERM).

DERM will inspect the site where the contaminated waste originated.

COMPREHENSIVE FINES WILL APPLY..

Upon receiving the all clear from DERM, Darrens Asbestos Removal will safely dispose of all contaminated waste **AT THE HIRERS EXPENSE.**
